



Cerevi, Life Regeneration Center



The Cerevi (Life Regeneration Center) offers a rainforest experience on a spiraling ramp where visitors can observe the different rainforest strata. It is a space for learning about the jungle and regeneration, as well as an activity center that can accommodate workshops and events related to regeneration.

Our actions

The CEREBI offers a rainforest experience for visitors to learn more about this habitat and regeneration.

In addition, we also run workshops on food awareness, biodynamic agriculture and practices to connect with the body, among others; and the CEREBI is also set up for work meetings with a unique focus on territory.

Finally, our visitors can stay overnight at the CEREBI in yurt accommodations inspired in traditional nomadic dwellings. The yurts provide people with comfortable lodging but also immersion in the jungle, so they can listen and observe everything going on there. We use dry toilets, treating waste by decomposition and using the solid compost as organic fertilizer. Visitors are also provided with eco-friendly personal hygiene items so as not to contaminate the natural surroundings.

Daily meals consist of typical local foods and a varied, healthy menu, including vegetables sourced mainly from our agroecological garden. All meals are made by local people.



Our edge

Stratified design

The Cerevi's construction is inspired by the shade grown yerba mate system. It is designed for visitors to identify the characteristics of each strata of the rainforest: from the forest floor with small animals and low vegetation up to the lookout with a view of the Iguazú River, where they can contemplate the rainforest from its highest point.



Fibonacci spiral structure

We created a design that replicates the Fibonacci sequence in the middle of the rainforest. This sacred geometry is often found in nature, such as in the petals of a sunflower or a snail's shell. Moving along the spiraling path invites us to shift perspectives, strengthening our powers of observation and moving our perception. It is an experience that must be lived, hard to put into words.

The importance of symbolism

We created the Cerevi with a strong focus on symbols. Each yurt has been assigned an animal guardian inspired by local wildlife, and a chakra or energy center identified by its characteristic color. We chose the animals using radiesthesia techniques to locate each animal guardian in the forest strata where each yurt is located.



Path open to everyone

The Cerevi's structure does not have steps or impediments that could hinder visitors in wheelchairs. The entire spiral structure from beginning to the lookout at the end is one big ramp. The doorways of the yurts are wide enough to accommodate entry with assistance. Regeneration here is open to everyone.
